

Revelation according to John (son of Zebedee)

1 Chapter

1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant John:

2 Who bore record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.

3 Blessed *is* he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time *is* at hand.

4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;

5 And from Jesus Christ, *who is* the faithful witness, *and* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

(Ex C19 V3 And Moses went up to **God**, and the **LORD** called to him out of the mountain, Saying, Thus shall you say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel;

V4 You have seen what **I** did to the Egyptians, and how **I** bore you on eagles' wings, and brought you to myself.

V5 Now therefore, if you will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then you shall be a peculiar treasure to me above all people: for all the earth is mine:

V6 And you shall be to me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the Words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.)

7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

(JESUS fills the sky Matt C24 V27 “For as the lightning comes out of the east, and shines even to the west; so shall also the coming of the **Son** of man be.” *at HIS 2nd coming,*

Zech C12 V10 And I will pour on the house of David, and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look on me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.)

8 I am **Alpha** and **Omega**, the beginning and the ending, saith the **Lord**, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the **Almighty**.

Heb C13 V8 **Jesus Christ** the same yesterday, and today, and forever.

9 I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord’s day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

(JESUS’ voice as a trumpet, last trump?)

11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send *it* unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto **Ephesus**, and unto **Smyrna**, and unto **Pergamos**, and unto **Thyatira**, and unto **Sardis**, and unto **Philadelphia**, and unto **Laodicea**.

12 And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks *one* like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

(Dan C10 V5 Then I lifted up my eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz:

V6 His body also was like the beryl, and his face as the appearance of lightning, and his eyes as lamps of fire, and his arms and his feet like in color to polished brass, and the voice of his words like the voice of a multitude.)

14 His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;

(Dan C7 V9 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the **Ancient** of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire.

Rev C19 V12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.)

15 And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

(Dan C10 V5 Then I lifted up my eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz:

V6 His body also was like the beryl, and his face as the appearance of lightning, and his eyes as lamps of fire, and his arms and his feet like in color to polished brass, and the voice of his words like the voice of a multitude.)

16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp two edged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

(Rev C19 V15 And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treads the wine press of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.)

17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

18 *I am* he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

19 Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;

(Write the past, the Present & the future)

20 The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

(Seen REV 1:1-20)

2 chapter (Rev)

1 Unto the angel of the church of **Ephesus** write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

(Some believes this is the period 33AD to 100AD; Apostolic Church)

2 I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars:

3 And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.

4 Nevertheless I have *somewhat against thee*, because thou hast left thy first love.

5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and **repent**, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou **repent**.

6 But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the **Nicolaitans**, which I also hate.

(Wikipedia ref; Several of the early church fathers mentioned this group, including Irenaeus, Hippolytus, ^[2] Epiphanius, and Theodoret, stating that deacon Nicolas was the author of the heresy and the sect.)

7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

8 And unto the angel of the church in **Smyrna** write; These things saith the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

(Some believes this the period 100AD to 312AD; Era of Persecution Under the Ten Caesars)

9 I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and *I know* the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but *are* the synagogue of Satan.

10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast *some* of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

(Righteous)

12 And to the angel of the church in **Pergamos** write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

(Some believes this is the period 312AD to 590AD; Era of Church-State Union)

13 I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, *even* where Satan's seat *is*: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my

(only mention in the Christian Bible, believe **Saint Antipas** martyred 92 AD ref Wikipedia)

faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.

14 But I have a *few things against thee*, because thou hast there them that hold the *doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac* to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

(Num C22 – 24,

Num C31 V16 Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the **LORD** in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the **LORD**.

2 Pet C2 V15 Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

Jude V11 Woe to them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.)

15 So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the **Nicolaitans**, which thing I hate.

(Wikipedia ref; Several of the early church fathers mentioned this group, including Irenaeus, Hippolytus,^[2] Epiphanius, and Theodoret, stating that deacon Nicolas was the author of the heresy and the sect.)

16 **Repent; or else** I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth *it*.

18 And unto the angel of the church in **Thyatira** write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass;

(Some believes this is the period 590AD to 1517AD; Era Spanning the Dark / Middle Ages)

19 I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last *to be* more than the first.

20 Notwithstanding I have a *few things against thee*, because thou sufferest that woman **Jezebel**, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

(1Kings C16 V30 And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the **LORD** above all that were before him.

V31 And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him.

1Kings C18 V13 Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the **LORD'S** prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water?

1Kings C21 V14 Then they sent to Jezebel, saying, Naboth is stoned, and is dead.

V15 And it came to pass, when Jezebel heard that Naboth was stoned, and was dead, that Jezebel said to Ahab, Arise, take possession of the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give thee for money: for Naboth is not alive, but dead.)

21 And I gave her space to **repent** of her fornication; and she repented not.

22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they **repent** of their deeds.

23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

25 But that which ye have *already* hold fast till I come.

26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

28 And I will give him the morning star.

29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

3 chapter (Rev)

1 And unto the angel of the church in **Sardis** write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

(Some believes this is the period 1517AD to 1750AD; Protestant Reformation)

2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.

3 Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and **repent**. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.

4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.

5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life,

but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

6 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

7 And to the angel of the church in **Philadelphia** write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

(Some believe this is the period 1750AD to 1925AD; Era of Revival and Great Awakening)

8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation,

(is Jesus speaking of "the Mark of the beast" when saying temptation? Is this possibly the rapture?)

which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, *which is* new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and *I will write upon him* my new name.

13 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (Righteous)

14 And unto the angel of the church of the **Laodiceans** write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

(Some believe this is CURRENT 1925AD to NOW; Era of "Higher Criticism")

(Colossians C2)

15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and *that* the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and **repent**.

20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

22 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

4 chapter (Rev)

1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, **Come up hither**, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter. (the future)

2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and *one* sat on the throne.

(pre-tribulation people, believe this is the rapture because God called him up)

(Some believe the 7year tribulation starts at the first seal breaking and the Mid-tribulation is at the 7th Trumpet. This is where some believe the rapture happens: see REV 14:16)

(take literally – John taken to heaven & receives the vision/revelation, returns to earth still in mortal body & at a future date dies therefore did not receive an immortal body as in

- 1 Cor C15 V51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
V52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the **last trump**: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
V53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.
V54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.
- 1 Thes C4 V13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.
V14 For if we believe that **Jesus** died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will **God** bring with him.
V15 For this we say unto you by the word of the **Lord**, that we which are alive *and* remain unto the coming of the **Lord** shall not prevent them which are asleep.
V16 For the **Lord** himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of **God**: and the dead in **Christ** shall rise first:
V17 Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.)

3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and *there* was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

(Eze C1 V26 And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it.

V27 And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about.

V28 As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.)

4 And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

(Isa C11 V2 Lord, Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Might, Knowledge & Fear of the Lord)

6 And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four beasts full of eyes before and behind.

7 And the first beast was like a lion, and the second beast like a calf, and the third beast had a face as a man, and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle.

(Ezekiel's vision of the beast (Eze C1 V5 & 10)

Lion-----Matthew (Good news)-- King

Ox (Calf)---Mark (Good news)-----Servant

Man-----Luke (Good news)-----Son of Man

Eagle----- John (Good news)-----Son of God)

8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

(Isa C6 V1 In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.

V2 Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.

V3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the **LORD** of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.)

9 And when those beasts give glory and honour and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever,
10 The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying,
11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

5 chapter (Rev)

1 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

(the Deed for our sins, what is owed for sin, no man could pay, only Jesus)

2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?

(Book here is better translated scroll. Israelis wrote mortgages/loans on scrolls rolled them up & sealed them. On the outside of the rolled-up scroll would be the public info such as lot number or property boundaries. On the inside would be the private items such as the terms of the mortgage/loan. Adam lost dominion over the earth to satan when he sinned. Nobody but **JESUS** could redeem us & creation therefore **HE** is the only one who could open/redeem the scroll/mortgage/dominion over earth.)

3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

(these seals are not stating God's wrath)

6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

(Dan C7 V9 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the **Ancient** of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire.

V10 A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered to him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

V11 I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spoke: I beheld even till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

V12 As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time.

V13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the **Son** of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the **Ancient** of days, and they brought him near before him.

V14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.)

8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four *and* twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints.

(Pray wisely) Psalms C141 V2 Let my prayer be set forth before you as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

1Pet 4:7 But the end of all things is at hand: be you therefore sober, and watch to prayer.

9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and

hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

(Ex C19 V3 And Moses went up unto **God**, and the **LORD** called unto him out of the mountain, saying, Thus shalt thou say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel;

V4 Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and *how* I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself.

V5 Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth *is* mine:

V6 And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These *are* the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.)

11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;

12 Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.

13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and

power, *be* unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

14 And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four *and* twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.

6 chapter (Rev) - chronological

1 And I saw when the Lamb opened **one of the seals**, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

2 And I saw, and behold a **white horse**: and he that sat on him

(Some believe this is the false church – it will derive from Catholicism and others believe It will be a combination of sue do religions)

(Zech C6 V3 And in the third chariot white horses; and in the fourth chariot grisled and bay horses.

Matt C24 V4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

*V5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am **Christ**; and shall deceive many.*

-do not be deceived!)

had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

3 And when he had opened the **second seal**, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

4 And there went out another **horse** that was **red**: and *power*

(Some believe this is communism)

(Some believe it is Russia)

was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should **kill one another**: and there was given unto him a great sword.

(A point of view, Eze 38:21 And I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord GOD: every man's sword shall be against his brother.)

(Zec C6 V2 In the first chariot were red horses; and in the second chariot black horses;

Matt C24 V6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

V7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

-wars & rumors, nation against nation!)

5 And when he had opened the **third seal**, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a **black horse**; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

(Some believe this is the world economy – oil & wine represent the finer things in life)

(Some believe is world famine due to the wars from the Red Horse)

(Zec C6 V2 In the first chariot were red horses; and in the second chariot black horses;

Matt C24 V7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.)

Amos C8-V9 And it shall come to pass in that day, said the **Lord GOD**, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken the earth in the clear day:

V10 And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation; and I will bring up sackcloth on all loins, and baldness on every head; and I will make it as the mourning of an only son, and the end thereof as a bitter day.

V11 Behold, the days come, said the **Lord GOD**, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the **LORD**:

V12 And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the **LORD**, and shall not find it.

V13 In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for thirst. *-famines!*

7 And when he had opened the **fourth seal**, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.

8 And I looked, and behold a **pale horse**: and his name that sat

(Some believe this Islam pale = green in Greek)

(Some believe this is pestilence)

(Zec C6 V3 And in the third chariot white horses; and in the fourth chariot grisled and bay horses.

Matt C24 V7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. *- pestilences!*

on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

(A point of view; Matthew 24: 7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.)

(1/4 or 25% of human race killed at 4th seal so 75% remains)

(Matt C24 V8 All these are the beginning of sorrows. *- beginning of sorrows/last 7 years/tribulation)*

9 And when he had opened the **fifth seal**, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

(A belief, people will turn to **Christ** and be persecuted till **Yeshua** comes again)

(all believers prior to the last 7 years who died for word of **GOD Rev C12V9,10** & first part of **V11** plus believers' who died for word of **GOD** in the last 7 years – tribulation saints last part of **V11**)

12 And I beheld when he had opened the **sixth seal**, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the **wrath of the Lamb**:

17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? (6Rev)

7 chapter (Rev) – parenthetical but before the 7 trumpets

1 And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.

(Rev C8 V7 a third of trees & grass is burned up)

4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: *and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.*

5 Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.

6 Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Nepthalim were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.

(Matt C1 V10 And Ezekias begat Manasses; and Manasses begat Amon; and Amon begat Josias; Manasses replaced the tribe of Dan)

7 Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.

8 Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand.

Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.

(tribe of Dan is replaced with the tribe of Manasses)

(tribe of Dan not listed due to being 1st into idolatry,

- Jud C18 V14** Then answered the five men that went to spy out the country of Laish, and said unto their brethren, Do ye know that there is in these houses an ephod, and teraphim, and a graven image, and a molten image? now therefore consider what ye have to do.
- V15** And they turned thitherward, and came to the house of the young man the Levite, even unto the house of Micah, and saluted him.
- V16** And the six hundred men appointed with their weapons of war, which were of the children of Dan, stood by the entering of the gate.
- V17** And the five men that went to spy out the land went up, and came in thither, and took the graven image, and the ephod, and the teraphim, and the molten image: and the priest stood in the entering of the gate with the six hundred men that were appointed with weapons of war.
- V18** And these went into Micah's house, and fetched the carved image, the ephod, and the teraphim, and the molten image. Then said the priest unto them, What do ye?
- V19** And they said unto him, Hold thy peace, lay thine hand upon thy mouth, and go with us, and be to us a father and a priest: *is it* better for thee to be a priest unto the house of one man, or that thou be a priest unto a tribe and a family in Israel?
- V20** And the priest's heart was glad, and he took the ephod, and the teraphim, and the graven image, and went in the midst of the people.
- V21** So they turned and departed, and put the little ones and the cattle and the carriage before them.
- V22** And when they were a good way from the house of Micah, the men that were in the houses near to Micah's house were gathered together, and overtook the children of Dan.
- V23** And they cried unto the children of Dan. And they turned their faces, and said unto Micah, What aileth thee, that thou comest with such a company?
- V24** And he said, Ye have taken away my gods which I made, and the priest, and ye are gone away: and what have I more? and what *is* this that ye say unto me, What aileth thee?
- V25** And the children of Dan said unto him, Let not thy voice be heard among us, lest angry fellows run upon thee, and thou lose thy life, with the lives of thy household.
- V26** And the children of Dan went their way: and when Micah saw that they were too strong for him, he turned and went back unto his house.
- V27** And they took *the things* which Micah had made, and the priest which he had, and came unto Laish, unto a people that were at quiet and secure: and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and burnt the city with fire.
- V28** And *there was* no deliverer, because it was far from Zidon, and they had no business with any man; and it was in the valley that *lieth* by Bethrehob. And they built a city, and dwelt therein.
- V29** And they called the name of the city Dan, after the name of Dan their father, who was born unto Israel: howbeit the name of the city was Laish at the first.
- V30** And the children of Dan set up the graven image: and Jonathan, the son of Gershom, the son of Manasseh, he and his sons were priests to the tribe of Dan until the day of the captivity of the land.
- V31** And they set them up Micah's graven image, which he made, all the time that the house

of **God** was in Shiloh.

Ephraim referred to as the tribe of Joseph due to Ephraim being right hand blessed by Jacob/Israel

- Gen C48 V13** And Joseph took them both, Ephraim in his right hand toward Israel's left hand, and Manasseh in his left hand toward Israel's right hand, and brought *them* near unto him.
- V14** And Israel stretched out his right hand, and laid *it* upon Ephraim's head, who was the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's head, guiding his hands wittingly; for Manasseh was the firstborn.
- V15** And he blessed Joseph, and said, **God**, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, the **God** which fed me all my life long unto this day,
- V16** The Angel which redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.
- V17** And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to remove it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head.
- V18** And Joseph said unto his father, Not so, my father: for this *is* the firstborn; put thy right hand upon his head.
- V19** And his father refused, and said, I know *it*, my son, I know *it*: he also shall become a people, and he also shall be great: but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his seed shall become a multitude of nations.
- V20** And he blessed them that day, saying, In thee shall Israel bless, saying, **God** make thee as Ephraim and as Manasseh: and he set Ephraim before Manasseh.

These 144,000 go & teach the gospel of the kingdom throughout the world

Matt C24 V14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.)

9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

11 And all the angels stood round about the throne, and *about* the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God,

12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, *be* unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?

14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which **came out of great tribulation**, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

(These are tribulation saints living and who died for JESUS since they are before FATHER'S throne and the LAMB-JESUS, came out of the tribulation washed in the blood of the LAMB. V17 says they get lead to living waters as in Rev C22 V1)

15 Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

16 They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.

17 For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto **living fountains of waters**: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

(Eze C47 V1 Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward: for the forefront of the house *stood toward* the east, and the waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south *side* of the altar.

V2 Then brought he me out of the way of the gate northward, and led me about the way without unto the utter gate by the way that looketh eastward; and, behold, there ran out waters on the right side.

V3 And when the man that had the line in his hand went forth eastward, he measured a thousand cubits, and he brought me through the waters; the waters *were* to the ankles.

V4 Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters *were* to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters *were* to the loins.

V5 Afterward he measured a thousand; *and it was* a river that I could not pass over: for the waters *were* risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

V6 And he said unto me, **Son** of man, hast thou seen *this*? Then he brought me, and caused me to return to the brink of the river.

V7 Now when I had returned, behold, at the bank of the river *were* very many trees on the one side and on the other.

V8 Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into

the desert, and go into the sea: *which being* brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.

V9 And it shall come to pass, *that* every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

V10 And it shall come to pass, *that* the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; they shall be a *place* to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.

Joel C3 V18 And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the **LORD**, and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Zec C14 V8 And it shall be in that day, *that* living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

V9 And the **LORD** shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one **LORD**, and his name one.)

Chapter 8 (Rev) - **chronological**

1 And when he had opened the **seventh seal**, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.

2 And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets.

3 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.

4 And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.

5 And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast *it* into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake.

6 And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

(it does not say God's wrath only "seven angels...seven trumpets prepared")

7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

8 And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood;

9 And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.

10 And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

11 And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.

(A point of view; Wormwood = Chernobyl Chernobyl was a town in the Ukraine where a nuclear plant had a chemical explosion which damage the reactor leaking radioactive material)

(If Wormwood = Chernobyl then when did the 1st & 2nd trumpet sound? I do not remember 1/3 of trees/grass burnt up or 1/3 of the ocean turning to blood, 1/3 of ocean animals die & 1/3 of ships destroyed!)

12 And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

13 And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound! (three woes)

Chapter 9 (Rev) - **chronological**

1 And the **fifth angel sounded**, and I saw a star *fall* from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.

(Is this satan? *Fall* versus *come down* as in **Rev C20 V1 – 3**.)

Isa C14 V12 How are you fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how are you cut down to the ground, which did weaken the nations!

V13 For you have said in your heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of **God**: I will sit also on the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

Luke C10 V18 And he said to them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.)

2 And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.

(may be Yellowstone volcano)

3 And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

4 And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.

(144,000 from **Rev C7 V2 – 8** have the seal of **GOD**)

5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.

6 And in those days shall men seek death, and shall not find it; and shall desire to die, and death shall flee from them.

7 And the shapes of the locusts *were* like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads *were* as it were crowns like gold, and their faces *were* as the faces of men.

8 And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as *the teeth* of lions.

9 And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.

10 And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to hurt men five months.

11 And they had a king over them, *which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon.* (1st woe)

12 One woe is past; and, behold, there come two woes more hereafter.

13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

(75% of mankind left from Rev C6 V8 so [1/3][75% of mankind left from Rev C6 V8] = 50% left of mankind or 50% of mankind has been killed since 1st seal broken)

16 And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

(200 million man army)

17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

18 By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.

19 For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails *were* like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.

20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

21 Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Chapter 10 (Rev) - **parenthetical**

1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow *was* upon his head, and his face *was* as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

2 And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and *his* left *foot* on the earth,

3 And cried with a loud voice, as *when* a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

(NOT MEANT FOR US TO KNOW!!!)(YET!!!!) **Duet C29 V29** The secret things belong to the **LORD** our **God**: but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.)

5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven,

6 And sware by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer:

7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

(does this mean by the 7th Trump "the mystery of **God**" complete?)

Dan C12 V7 And I heard the man clothed in linen, which was upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and sware by him that liveth for ever that *it shall be* for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these *things* shall be finished.)

(Look at Dan C12, V11 And from the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that makes desolate set up, there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days.

This indicates that this occurs at the midpoint because there are about 3.5 years left till the end or **CHRIST'S** return. 1290 days is **CHRIST'S** return 1260 + 30 days for judgement

(**Eze C20 V33** As I live, said the **Lord GOD**, surely with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out, will I rule over you:

V34 And I will bring you out from the people, and will gather you out of the countries wherein you are scattered, with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out.

V35 And I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there will I plead with you face to face.

V36 Like as I pleaded with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so will I plead with you, said the **Lord GOD**.

V37 And I will cause you to pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant:

V38 And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and you shall know that I am the **LORD**.

V39 As for you, O house of Israel, thus said the **Lord GOD**; Go you, serve you everyone his idols, and hereafter also, if you will not listen to me: but pollute you my holy name no more with your gifts, and with your idols.

V40 For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, said the **Lord GOD**, there shall all the house of Israel, all of them in the land, serve me: there will I accept them, and there will I require your offerings, and the first fruits of your oblations, with all your holy things.

V41 I will accept you with your sweet smell, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein you have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you before the heathen.

V42 And you shall know that I am the **LORD**, when I shall bring you into the land of Israel, into the country for the which I lifted up my hand to give it to your fathers.

V43 And there shall you remember your ways, and all your doings, wherein you have been defiled; and you shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for all your evils that you have committed.

V44 And you shall know that I am the **LORD** when I have worked with you for my name's sake, not according to your wicked ways, nor according to your corrupt doings, O you house of Israel, said the **Lord GOD**.

Joel C3 V2 I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.

V3 And they have cast lots for my people; and have given a boy for an harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they might drink.

Matt C25 V31 When the **Son** of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit on the throne of his glory:

V32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats:

V33 And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

V34 Then shall the **King** say to them on his right hand, Come, you blessed of my **Father**, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

V35 For I was an hungered, and you gave me meat: I was thirsty, and you gave me drink: I was a stranger, and you took me in:

V36 Naked, and you clothed me: I was sick, and you visited me: I was in prison, and you came to me.

V37 Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, **Lord**, when saw we you an hungered, and fed you? or thirsty, and gave you drink?

V38 When saw we you a stranger, and took you in? or naked, and clothed you?

V39 Or when saw we you sick, or in prison, and came to you?

V40 And the **King** shall answer and say to them, Truly I say to you, Inasmuch as you have done it to one of the least of these my brothers, you have done it to me.

V41 Then shall he say also to them on the left hand, Depart from me, you cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

V42 For I was an hungered, and you gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and you gave me no drink:

V43 I was a stranger, and you took me not in: naked, and you clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and you visited me not.

V44 Then shall they also answer him, saying, **Lord**, when saw we you an hungered, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister to you?

V45 Then shall he answer them, saying, Truly I say to you, Inasmuch as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to me.

V46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

-1335 days is for old testament saints? or blessed are people who survive the tribulation 1260 + 75 days to enter **CHRIST'S** millennial kingdom? Mystery of **GOD** complete, Paul's writing reveal mysteries all concerning the grace of **GOD**. After the 7th trump there is no more grace from **GOD** [C15 V8], only the wrath of **GOD**.)

8 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go *and* take the little book which is open in

the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.

9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take *it*, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

10 And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

11 And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

Chapter 11 (Rev) - **chronological**

1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, (the 3rd Temple) and the altar, and them that worship therein.

2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty *and* two months.

3 And I will give *power* unto my two witnesses, and they shall *prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.*

(one of the witnesses I believe is Elijah –

MAI C4 V5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:)

(so do the witness start after the 6th trump? Or is this parenthetic, meaning they start their proselytizing about the time the seals are open. Because the abomination has not happen yet)

(Heb C9 V27 – ...man dies once..., *so one might assume the witnesses are*

1. **Enoch** from Gen C5 V24 And Enoch walked with **God**: and he was not; for **God** took him.

and

Elijah From 2 Kings C2 V11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder;

and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven. ”

or

2. **Moses (law), who called plaques on Egypt** **Ex C7 – C11**, but had died **Deut C34 V5** “So Moses the servant of the **LORD** died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the **LORD**. Isa C13 V13 Therefore I will shake the heavens, and the earth shall remove out of her place, in the wrath of the **LORD** of hosts, and in the day of his fierce anger.

C34 V8 For it is the day of the **LORD's** vengeance, and the year of recompenses for the controversy of Zion.

exactly when??????? **GOD'S** witnesses vs false witnesses against **CHRIST**

Matt C26 V59 Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against **Jesus**, to put him to death;

V60 But found none: yes, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. At the last came two false witnesses,

(satan possesses/indwells the antichrist as satan possessed/indwelled Judas –

Luke C22 V3 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.

John C13 V27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said **Jesus** to him, That you do, do quickly.)

14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the **serpent**.

(**Dan C7 V25** And he shall speak great words against the most **High**, and shall wear out the saints of the most **High**, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.)

2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as *the feet of a bear*, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion:

(similar to

DAN C7 V4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

V17 These great beasts, which are four, are four kings, which shall arise out of the earth.

V18 But the saints of the most **High** shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever.

V19 Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his nails of brass; which devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet;

V20 And of the ten horns that were in his head, and of the other which came up, and before whom three fell; even of that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, whose look was more stout than his fellows.

V22 Until the **Ancient** of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most **High**; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.

Chapter 16 (Rev) - **chronological**

2 And the **first** went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and *upon* them which worshipped his image.

9 And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.

10 And the **fifth** angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,

11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

12 And the **sixth** angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

(usually taught that the kings of the east bring the 200 million man army of **REV C9 V16**)

13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs *come* out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

(**REV13:11** lamb w/2 horns = false prophet)

14 For they are the spirits of **devils**, working miracles, *which* go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed *is* he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.

(ar = hill/mountain of, mageddon = Megiddo, hill of megiddo,)

Joel C3 V2 I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.

Zeph C3 V88 Therefore wait you on me, said the **LORD**, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour on them my indignation, even all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy. *-gather nations/assembly kingdoms*

Isa C13 V6 Howl you; for the day of the **LORD** is at hand; it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty.

V7 Therefore shall all hands be faint, and every man's heart shall melt:

V8 And they shall be afraid: pangs and sorrows shall take hold of them; they shall be in pain as a woman that travails: they shall be amazed one at another; their faces shall be as flames.

V9 Behold, the day of the **LORD** comes, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. *- day of the LORD*

17 And the **seventh** angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.

18 And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, *and* so great.

19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

21 And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

(talent ~ 100 lbs which fall on the armies (200 million men) gathered near Jezeraal, Jehoshaphat & Kidron vallies so that the blood rose to the bridles of horses **REV C14 V20**)

Chapter 17 (Rev) - **parenthetical**

1 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth

(Some believes it is a organize religion that is a mixture of Christianity & paganism)

upon many waters:

2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication,

(possible NY city the United Nations)

and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.

(maybe NY city with her stock exchange and UN)

3 So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

(A point of view define this as the woman a harlot religion and the beast with 7 heads and 10 horns the Dragon's government) (look at some EU/European countries' currency/stamps & the statue in front of the EU headquarters in Brussels, both show a women on a bull – revived roman empire – in Europe)

4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

5 And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

6 And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

7 And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns.

(Dan C7)

8 The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

(those not written in the book of life will wonder after her)

9 And here *is* the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth.

(the 7 heads are 7 mountains)(some say possible Rome due to being built on 7 hills, elsewhere in bible mountains = kingdoms, beast of **REV V7** has seven heads or seven heads of kingdoms)

10 And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.

(5 kings past one current and yet to come has a short time)

11 And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

12 And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.

(Dan C7) (10 kings will have power for one hour through the beast)

13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.

(10 kings and the beast will work together)

14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him *are* called, and chosen, and faithful.

(the 10 kings and beast will be defeated by Jesus)

15 And he saith unto me, The waters which thou sawest, where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.

(the waters = are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues)

The sea = waters of people

DAN C7 V3 And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another.)

16 And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.

(the 10 kings hate the whore Babylon and will destroy her)

17 For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

18 And the woman which thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth.

(may be New York with the new world order / United Nations?)

Chapter 18 (Rev) - **parenthetical**

1 And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.

2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

(maybe New York city the UN all nations go to intermingle=fornication NY stock exchange=abundance delicacies)

4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

(another view of the Rapture?)

5 For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities.

6 Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.

7 How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

8 Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong *is* the Lord God who judgeth her.

9 And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her,

(NY stock exchange / united nations)

shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,

10 Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

11 And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:

12 The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all

manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,

13 And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.

14 And the fruits that thy soul lusted after are departed from thee, and all things which were dainty and goodly are departed from thee, and thou shalt find them no more at all.

15 The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,

16 And saying, Alas, alas, that great city, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

17 For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,

18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What *city is* like unto this great city!

19 And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate.

20 Rejoice over her, *thou* heaven, and ye holy apostles and prophets; for God hath avenged you on her.

21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast *it* into the sea,

(possible a tsunami from La Palma island part of the Canary chain hit NY city)

saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

22 And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft he be, shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee;

23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived.

24 And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth.

Chapter 19 (Rev) - **chronological**

1 And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:

2 For true and righteous *are* his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.

3 And again they said, Alleluia. And her smoke rose up for ever and ever.

4 And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia.

5 And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great.

6 And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.

7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

9 And he saith unto me, Write, *Blessed are they* which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See *thou do it* not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

[Titus C2 V13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ;](#)

12 His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and on his head *were* many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called **The Word of God**.

14 And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

(Heb C4 V12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.)

16 And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all *men, both* free and bond, both small and great.

19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that

(REV13:11 lamb w/ 2 horns)

wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which *sword* proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Chapter 20 (Rev) - **chronological**

1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

2 And he laid hold on the **dragon**, that **old serpent**, which is the **Devil**, and **Satan**, and bound him a thousand years,

3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and **after** that he must be loosed a little season.

(humans born during the millennial reign of **CHRIST** must be tempted therefore satan loosed for a season)

4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had **not** worshipped the beast,

(so people during the tribulation will come to **Christ**)

(**Dan C12 V11** And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which stands for the children of your people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time your people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.)

(**Matt C19 V27** Then answered Peter and said to him, Behold, we have forsaken all, and followed you; what shall we have therefore?

V28 And **Jesus** said to them, Truly I say to you, That you which have followed me, in the regeneration when the **Son** of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, you also shall sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.)

neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

(Psalms C2 V6 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

V7 I will declare the decree: the **LORD** hath said unto me, Thou *art* my **Son**; this day have I begotten thee.

V8 Ask of me, and I shall give *thee* the heathen *for* thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth *for* thy possession.

Isaiah C2 V1 The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

V2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, *that* the mountain of the **LORD'S** house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.

V3 And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the **LORD**, to the house of the **God** of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the **LORD** from Jerusalem.

V4 And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

5 But the rest of the dead lived **not** again until the thousand years were finished. This *is* the first resurrection.

(Dan C12 V2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.)

6 **Blessed** and **holy** *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

7 And when the thousand years are **expired**, **Satan** shall be loosed out of his prison,

8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom *is* as the sand of the sea.

9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

(CHRIST on earth ruling from Mt Zion/Jerusalem so the fire is from GOD the FATHER in heaven)

10 And the **devil** that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book of life*: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

(book of life is those who believe in JESUS CHRIST therefore saved, the books are all the works/deeds of those who do not believe in JESUS CHRIST & thus they are judged by their works/deeds – “For all have sinned and come short of the glory of GOD”

Rom C3 V23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of **God**;

Isa C66 V6 A voice of noise from the city, a voice from the temple, a voice of the **LORD** that renders recompense to his enemies.)

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. **(JESUS judges**

mankind

John C5 V22 For the **Father** judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

Matt C5 V22 But I say to you, That whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whoever shall say, You fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

V23 Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has ought against you;

V24 Leave there your gift before the altar, and go your way; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

V25 Agree with your adversary quickly, whiles you are in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver you to the judge, and the judge deliver you to the officer, and you be cast into prison.

V26 Truly I say to you, You shall by no means come out there, till you have paid the uttermost farthing.

V27 You have heard that it was said by them of old time, You shall not commit adultery:

V28 But I say to you, That whoever looks on a woman to lust after her has committed adultery with her already in his heart.

V29 And if your right eye offend you, pluck it out, and cast it from you: for it is profitable for you that one of your members should perish, and not that your whole body should be cast into hell.)

2Pet C3 V7 But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved to fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the **second death**.

(the 1st death is separation from our bodies, the 2nd death is separation from **GOD**)

15 And whosoever was **not** found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

(Daniel 12: 2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.)

(**Matt C25 V31** When the **Son** of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit on the throne of his glory:

V32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats:

V33 And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

V34 Then shall the **King** say to them on his right hand, Come, you blessed of my **Father**, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

V35 For I was an hungered, and you gave me meat: I was thirsty, and you gave me drink: I was a stranger, and you took me in:

V36 Naked, and you clothed me: I was sick, and you visited me: I was in prison, and you came to me.

V37 Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, **Lord**, when saw we you an hungered, and fed you? or thirsty, and gave you drink?

V38 When saw we you a stranger, and took you in? or naked, and clothed you?

V39 Or when saw we you sick, or in prison, and came to you?

V40 And the **King** shall answer and say to them, Truly I say to you, Inasmuch as you have done it to one of the least of these my brothers, you have done it to me.

V41 Then shall he say also to them on the left hand, Depart from me, you cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

V42 For I was an hungered, and you gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and you gave me no drink:

- V43 I was a stranger, and you took me not in: naked, and you clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and you visited me not.
- V44 Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we you an hungered, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister to you?
- V45 Then shall he answer them, saying, Truly I say to you, Inasmuch as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to me.
- V46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.)

Chapter 21 (Rev) – **chronological then eternity (no time)**

1 And I saw a **new heaven and a new earth**: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

2Pet C3 V10 But the day of the **Lord** will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

V11 Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,

V12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of **God**, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

V13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.)

Isa C65 V17 For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind.

C66 V22 For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the **LORD**, so shall your seed and your name remain.

Matt C24 V35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

Mark C13 V31 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

Luke C21 V33 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

Heb C12 V26 Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.

V27 And this word, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain.

2 Pet C3 V13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

2 And I John saw the holy city, **new Jerusalem**, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.

6 And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

11 Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

12 And had a wall great and high, *and* had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are *the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel*:

(**Eze C48 V31** And the gates of the city *shall be* after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi.

V32 And at the east side four thousand and five hundred: and three gates; and one gate of Joseph, one gate of Benjamin, one gate of Dan.

V33 And at the south side four thousand and five hundred measures: and three gates; one gate of Simeon, one gate of Issachar, one gate of Zebulun.

V34 At the west side four thousand and five hundred, *with* their three gates; one gate of Gad, one gate of Asher, one gate of Naphtali.

V35 It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, The **LORD** is there.)

13 On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.

14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

(**Matt C19 V27** Then answered Peter and said unto him, Behold, we have forsaken all, and followed thee; what shall we have therefore?

V28 And **Jesus** said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the **Son** of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Gal C2 V9 And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we should go unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.)

15 And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.

16 And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

(cubed / pyramid) (1500 miles X 1500 miles x 1500 miles, depending on furlong – 1380 X 1380 X 1380)

17 And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel. (thick)(72 yards thick)

18 And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold, like unto clear glass.

19 And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;

20 The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

21 And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

22 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

(Isa C24 V23 Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when the **LORD** of hosts shall reign in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously.

C60 V19 The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the **LORD** shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy **God** thy glory.

V20 Thy sun shall no more go down; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself: for the **LORD** shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.)

24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

25 And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.

(Isa C60 V11 Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought.

V20 Thy sun shall no more go down; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself: for the **LORD** shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.

Zec C14 V7 But it shall be one day which shall be known to the **LORD**, not day, nor night: but it shall come to pass, *that* at evening time it shall be light.)

26 And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.

27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither *whatsoever* worketh abomination, or *maketh* a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.

(Isa C52 V1 Awake, awake; put on thy strength, O Zion; put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city: for henceforth there shall no more come into thee the uncircumcised and the unclean.

C60 V21 Thy people also *shall be* all righteous: they shall inherit the land for ever, the branch of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified.)

Chapter 22 (Rev) - eternity (no time)

1 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

(Eze C47 V1 Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward: for the forefront of the house *stood toward* the east, and the waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south *side* of the altar.

V8 Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: *which being* brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.

V9 And it shall come to pass, *that* every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

V10 And it shall come to pass, *that* the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; they shall be a *place* to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.

Zec C14 V8 And it shall be in that day, *that* living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.)

2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, *was there* the tree of life, which bare twelve *manner of* fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

(**Eze C47 V12** And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed: it shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.: healing = therapeutic)

3 And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:

4 And they shall see his face; and his name *shall be* in their foreheads.

(**1 John C3 V2** Beloved, now are we the sons of **God**, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.)

5 And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.

(**Psalms C36 V9** For with thee *is* the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.

C84 V11 For the **LORD God** is a sun and shield: the **LORD** will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.)

6 And he said unto me, These sayings *are* faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.

7 Behold, I come quickly: blessed *is* he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.

8 And I John saw these things, and heard *them*. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things.

9 Then saith he unto me, See *thou do it* not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.

10 And he saith unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.

11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

(Dan C12 V10 Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.)

12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward *is* with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

(Isa C40 V10 Behold, the **LORD GOD** will come with strong *hand*, and his arm shall rule for him: behold, his reward *is* with him, and his work before him.

C62 V11 Behold, the **LORD** hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward *is* with him, and his work before him.

Rom C2 V6 Who will render to every man according to his deeds:)

13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

(Isa C41 V4 Who has worked and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? I the **LORD**, the first, and with the last; I am he.

C44 V6 Thus said the **LORD** the **King** of Israel, and his redeemer the **LORD** of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no **God**.

C48 V12 Listen to me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I am he; I am the first, I also am the last.)

14 Blessed *are* they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

15 For without *are* dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

16 I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, *and* the bright and morning star.

(Num C24 V17 I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not near: there shall come a **Star** out of Jacob, and a **Scepter** shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth.

- Zec C3 V1 And he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the **LORD**, and Satan standing at his right hand to resist him.
- V2 And the **LORD** said to Satan, The **LORD** rebuke you, O Satan; even the **LORD** that has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you: is not this a brand plucked out of the fire?
- V3 Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel.
- V4 And he answered and spoke to those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And to him he said, Behold, I have caused your iniquity to pass from you, and I will clothe you with change of raiment.
- V5 And I said, Let them set a fair turban on his head. So they set a fair turban on his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the **LORD** stood by.
- V6 And the angel of the **LORD** protested to Joshua, saying,
- V7 Thus said the **LORD** of hosts; If you will walk in my ways, and if you will keep my charge, then you shall also judge my house, and shall also keep my courts, and I will give you places to walk among these that stand by.
- V8 Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, you, and your fellows that sit before you: for they are men wondered at: for, behold, I will bring forth my servant the **BRANCH**.
- V9 For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; on one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the engraving thereof, said the **LORD** of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.
- V10 In that day, said the **LORD** of hosts, shall you call every man his neighbor under the vine and under the fig tree.
- C6 V12 And speak to him, saying, Thus speaks the **LORD** of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The **BRANCH**; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the **LORD**: -1st mention of church since REV C3)

17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

Isa C55 V1 Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

18 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall **add** unto these things, God shall **add** unto him the plagues that are written in this book:

(**Due C4 V2** You shall not add to the word which I command you, neither shall you diminish ought from it, that you may keep the commandments of the **LORD** your **God** which I command you.

C12 V32 What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: you shall not add thereto, nor diminish from it.)

19 And if any man shall **take away** from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall **take away** his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book.

(**Exo C32 V33** And the **LORD** said to Moses, Whoever has sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.

Psalms C69 V26 For they persecute him whom you have smitten; and they talk to the grief of those whom you have wounded.

V27 Add iniquity to their iniquity: and let them not come into your righteousness.

V28 Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the righteous.)

20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

21 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you all. Amen.
